Currently 46 countries

- ISSP is not centrally coordinated
- Members: national survey institutes
- Annual surveys in all member countries
- No central financing: some ISSP modules travel piggy-back

ES: How many persons live in your household, including yourself **and any servants?**

ZA: Please list all persons in the household **who eat from the same cooking pot** and were resident 15 out of the past 30 days.
